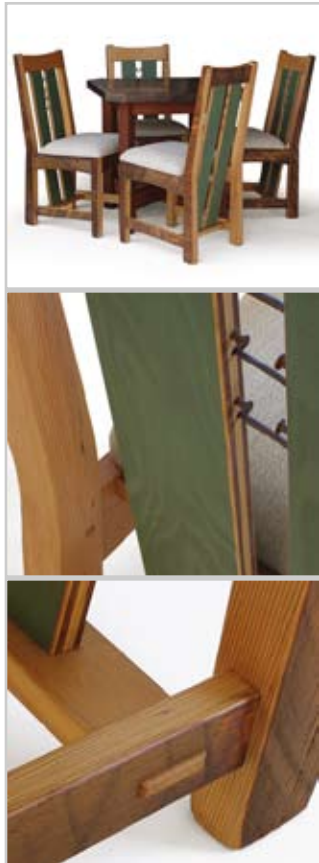

Handcrafted furniture from reclaimed materials

DINING CHAIRS- FIR VERTEBRAE BACK



Just as comfortable to sit in as it is pleasing to look at. Constructed from salvaged Douglas Fir that gives each chair a unique character and sense of history. The vertebrae back design, reminiscent of Frank Lloyd Wright, uses nails from the salvaged timber. Available with a colorful green painted back, or with unpainted bookmatched fir back. Either way, a delight.

Dimensions: 16"w 19"d 36"h

Seat height: 17"

Material: Douglas Fir salvaged from industrial demolition sites. The limited supply of specific materials means that each stool is unique.

Finish: Hand finished with tung oil. Over time the wood acquires a rich amber patina.

Upholstery: Leather, hemp, or customer-supplied material.

Production Time: 8 - 16 weeks
